In F-2002-0716, New York City Department of Sanitation, 44 Beaver Street, New York, New York 10004, has requested Department of Army authorization to dredge with ten year maintenance at five Marine Transfer Stations in Newton Creek, Hudson River, Flushing Bay, East River. The applicant proposes to dredge, with ten years maintenance, to maximum depth of 19 feet below mean low water with allowable two-foot overdepth at each facility. All dredging would be conducted using a sealed bucket and silt curtains. The applicant proposes to dredge five times at each facility during the ten year life of the permit, if issued, with removal of a total anticipated volume of approximately 113,000 cubic yards of material during each event. All initial and subsequent dredged material would be disposed at a state approved upland facility with no return flow into the waterway. The stated purpose of this project is to maintain adequate depths for navigation and mooring at the Transfer Station slips utilized by the applicant's barges. The project is located in the City of New York; Boroughs of Brooklyn, Manhattan, and Queens; Kings; New York and Queen Counties, State of New York.
