## PUBLIC NOTICE

### Department of Health

Pursuant to, but not required by, 42 CFR section 447.205, the Department of Health hereby gives public notice of the following:

The Department of Health proposes to amend Title XIX State Plan for personal care programs. The proposed amendments institute a two percent penalty for late filing of personal care cost reports; will establish a thirty day notice of the rate prior to January 1st of each rate

year and will allow programs an additional thirty days to submit any rate appeal of the initial January 1 Medicaid rate. Current regulations mandate that programs file the annual cost reports by a specific date. Approximately twenty percent of programs or 100 cost reports are not filed in a timely manner and 50 cost reports are not filed at all. This creates a significant amount of additional processing time and results in rates being issued well after the start of the effective period.

By instituting the late filing penalty, the Department can streamline its rate setting process and will be able to promulgate rates in a more timely and accurate manner. The amendments will also establish that personal care providers will receive notice of their initial rates thirty days prior to the effective date of the rate. This will allow programs to perform more accurate budget projections for their operations.

If 100 personal care providers in the state do not file a Medicaid cost report in a timely manner, the maximum penalty is estimated to be \$163,625 in annual aggregate Medicaid savings. In the event fewer reports are filed late, the penalty will be less than such maximum amount.

The New York State Department of State (DOS) is required by Federal regulations to provide timely public notice for the activities described below, which are subject to the consistency provisions of the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended.

The applicant has certified that the proposed activity complies with and will be conducted in a manner consistent with the approved New York State Coastal Management Program. The applicant's consistency certification and accompanying public information and data are available for inspection at the New York State Department of State offices located at 41 State Street in Albany, New York.

**In F-2003-0642, Algonquin Gas Transmission Company of 1284 Soldier's Field Road, Boston, MA 02135,** is proposing to install an approximately 3,200-foot-long cathodic protection ground bed in the Hudson River and the adjacent eastern shoreline are located on the Indian Point Energy Center property in the Town of Stony Point in Westchester County, and in the Village of Buchanan in Rockland County. The proposed ground bed is necessary to maintain adequate cathodic protection levels on three existing Algonquin natural gas transmission pipelines that cross the Hudson River in the general location of the project. The installation activities would include limited trenching and backfilling of cables along the river shoreline, and placing the ground bed components on the river bottom.

Approximately 120 cubic feet of sediments would be temporarily excavated in the intertidal zone to facilitate the burial of about 30 feet (15 feet on each line) of header cable. No excavation is proposed below mean low water. The remaining header cable and attached continuous anodes would be laid on the river bottom from a boat for a distance of approximately 3,000 linear feet. The proposed project is expected to take approximately 5-10 days to complete and is tentatively scheduled for late spring or summer of 2004.

**In F-2003-0879 (DA), The United States Coast Guard of 300 Metro Center Blvd., Warwick, RI 02886,** proposes to conduct maintenance dredging activities next to an existing pier at the US Coast Guard New York Station located in the Rosebank section on the eastern shore of Staten Island. The maintenance dredging would remove approximately 850 cubic yards within an approximately 0.14 acre area. Of this area, 0.1078 acres is considered littoral zone. The proposed depth is 9 feet below mean low water. Water depth proposed is greater than boat draft by approximately 4 feet. This overdepth dredging would reduce the need for future maintenance dredging. Dredging would be conducted with a clam shell. The material to be dredged is primarily comprised of accumulated sand (69.7%) and gravel (27.1%) with fines (3.3%). Minor constituents include brick and glass. The work is anticipated to be completed within one day.

The project location is at the US Coast Guard Station at the intersection of Bay Street and Nautilus Street, Rosebank, Staten Island, New York City, Richmond County.
