The New York State Department of State (DOS) is required by Federal regulations to provide timely public notice for the activities described below, which are subject to the consistency provisions of the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended.

The applicant has certified that the proposed activity complies with and will be conducted in a manner consistent with the approved New York State Coastal Management Program. The applicant's consistency certification and accompanying public information and data are available for inspection at the New York State Department of State offices located at 41 State Street in Albany, New York.

In F-2001-0921, the New York Power Authority, 30 South Pearl Street, Albany, New York 12207-3425 has applied to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) for the re-issuance of a 50-year license for the St. Lawrence - FDR Power project. The current 50-year license to operate this 912-MV hydroelectric project expires on October 31, 2003. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (successor to the Federal Power Commission) will act upon this application and has prepared an environmental impact statement (EIS) under The National Environmental Policy Act to address the impacts of the proposed action. Re-licensing measures proposed which may affect the coastal zone include: stabilizing eroding shorelines; providing habitat enhancements for aquatic and terrestrial species; conveying project lands to local municipalities and/or private individuals; adopting land management and cultural resources management plans; rehabilitating and improving recreation sites and recreational use of the project shoreline; and encouraging community development through lease of lands to the St. Lawrence Aquarium and Ecological Center. The project is located at the St. Lawrence River, St. Lawrence County.

Any interested parties and/or agencies desiring to express their views concerning the above proposed activities may do so by filing their comments, in writing, no later than 4:30 p.m., **15 days from the date of publication of this notice, or October 30, 2003.**
