Local Waterfront Revitalization Program Grants

The Department of State is soliciting applications from local governments for matching grants available under Title 11 of the Environmental Protection Fund (EPF) for local waterfront revitalization projects. Grant applications will be accepted through June 30 2004 for the following purposes:

- Urban waterfront redevelopment
- Preparing or implementing a waterbody/watershed management plan
- Coastal education and interpretive programs
- Making the most of your waterfront - community visioning and development of revitalization strategies
- Completing or implementing a Local Waterfront Revitalization Program
- Creating a Blueway Trail

Eligible applicants include municipalities (cities, towns and villages) located within the State Coastal Area or along a major inland waterway designated pursuant to Executive Law, Article 42.

Grants will be available for 50% of the total project cost.

Applications have been transmitted to all eligible municipalities.
