2004-0250 Matter of Leland Ploutz, 34055 State Highway 10, Walton, NY 13856 for a variance concerning the fire-safety requirement for automatic sprinklers systems throughout all buildings with a Group R residential fire area.

Involved is new construction of an R-1 (residential where the occupants are primarily transient in nature, a motel) occupancy in a proposed building of type VB-unprotected combustible construction, one story in height, and approximately 4,100 square feet in gross floor area, known as the "Octagon Motor Hotel", it will be located at 34350 State Highway 10, Town of Hamden, County of Delaware, State of New York.

2004-0264 Matter of Syracuse University, Office of Design and Construction, Skytop Bldg., 721 University Ave., Syracuse, NY 13210 for a variance concerning fire-safety requirements, including requirements for smoke control system in an atrium.

Involved are alterations to a C5.1 (assembly space for not more than 300 persons, a theater) company in an existing building of type 4b-unprotected ordinary masonry construction, 4 stories in height, and approximately 7,275 square feet in gross floor area, known as the "Waverly Opera House", it is located at 324 Broad Street, Village of Waverly, County of Tioga, State of New York.
