The project is scheduled to occur between the 15th of June and the 1st of October in order to avoid adverse water quality effects to the wildlife resources using the State-designated Great Sodus Bay Significant Coastal Fish and Wildlife Habitat. The project is located in Wayne County, Great Sodus Bay.
