PUBLIC NOTICE Department of Health Division of Health Care Standards and Surveillance Nursing Home Complaint Surveillance Project

In response to a continued back log of nursing home complaints in the Metropolitan Area Regional Office, (MARO), the Department of Health has sought assistance in the area of hiring Surveyors (nurses and social workers) since September 2001. The nursing home complaints will be emanating from locations in New York City and the five boroughs. Complaints to be investigated may include backlogs from previous years, and will include new incoming, onsite cases, as transmitted by the intake unit in Albany and as directed by DOH management staff. The Surveyors will continue to participate in all

aspects of the complaint process, including drafting Statements of Deficiency, assessing compliance with Plans of Correction onsite, and as necessary, monitoring facilities with cases of "immediate jeopardy" or other serious concerns. The New York State Department of State (DOS) is required by Federal law to provide timely public notice for the activity described below, which is subject to the consistency provisions of the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended.

The New York District of the Army Corps of Engineers has determined that the proposed activity complies with and will be conducted in a manner consistent to the maximum extent practicable with the approved New York State Coastal Management Program. The consistency determination and accompanying public information and data is available for inspection at the New York State Department of State offices located at 41 State Street in Albany, New York.

In F-2004-0210 DA, the New York District of the Army Corps of Engineers is proposing to Maintenance dredging in the Sequine Point Section of the Raritan Bay Reach of the New York and New Jersey Channels. Approximately 144,000 cubic yards of sediment will be dredged using clamshell dredge, hopper dredge or similar plant. The dredged material will be transported by scows or hopper dredge to a permitted, suitable upland site(s) furnished by the contractor and approved by the government. The Corps will obtain a Water Quality

Certificate (WQC) from the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation in accordance with Section 401 of the Clean Water Act.

Any interested parties and/or agencies desiring to express their views concerning the above proposed activity may do so by filing their comments, in writing, no later than 4:30 p.m., 15 days from the date of publication of this notice, or May 20, 2004.
