The United States Coast Guard has determined that the proposed activity complies with and will be conducted in a manner consistent to the maximum extent practicable with the approved New York State Coastal Management Program. The consistency determination and accompanying public information and data is available for inspection at the New York State Department of State offices located at 41 State Street in Albany, New York.

In F-2004-0914, the United States Coast Guard, Civil Engineering Unit, 300 Metro Center Blvd., Warwick, RI 02886, is proposing the replacement of an existing deteriorating pre-engineered metal shop building with a new structure of similar design at the U.S. Coast Guard Station Eatons Neck. The Station is located on the north shore of Long Island in Northport, NY where it faces Long Island Sound. The shop building is adjacent to the boathouse at the head of a narrow cove that connects to Long Island Sound north of Huntington Bay. Construction would include the following major elements: (1) Removal and disposal of the existing 20N x 50N metal building and electrical system; (2) Sections of new concrete slab within the existing foundation to form a level floor; (3) A new 20N x 50N pre-engineered metal shop/storage building utilizing the existing concrete foundation; and (4) Appropriate structural, electrical, and mechanical systems for the structure and building use.
