Projects that contribute to the preservation of significant research materials in libraries, archives, historical societies and other agencies in New York State, whether by conducting surveys, improving collection storage environments, reformatting or treating collections or other preservation activities described in the program guidelines

Applications must be received in the Conservation/Preservation office by 5:00 pm, December 3, 2004 for projects that meet the eligibility requirements. Applications received after 5:00 pm December 3, 2004 will be ineligible. A total of \$500,000 is available for Conservation/Preservation of library research materials. Grants will be available in amounts from \$1,500 to \$30,000.

The New York State Library, New York State Program for the Conservation and Preservation of Library Research Materials provided applications and guidelines to all requesting institutions and individuals in New York State. Minority and Women Revolving Loan Trust Fund Account

Applications will be accepted through November 4, 2004 in the form of proposals from organizations to administer a Minority and Women Revolving Loan Trust Fund Account ("Trust Fund Account") for communities in the Boroughs of Manhattan and the Bronx and the Counties of Westchester, Monroe and Onondaga. The selected organization will make low-cost working capital and fixed asset loans to

minority and women-owned businesses. ESDC will provide between \$115,000 and \$240,000 for this purpose, of which up to \$25,000 may be used toward administrative expenses of administering the Trust Fund Account.

Selected organizations will be expected to market the program, identify eligible businesses and assess their needs, and provide appropriate technical assistance before and after loan closing. Loan amounts may not exceed \$35,000 for working capital or \$50,000 for fixed assets.
