The New York State Department of State (DOS) is required by Federal regulations to provide timely public notice for the activities described below, which are subject to the consistency provisions of the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended.

The applicant has certified that the proposed activity complies with and will be conducted in a manner consistent with the approved New York State Coastal Management Program. The applicant's consistency certification and accompanying public information and data are available for inspection at the New York State Department of State offices located at 41 State Street in Albany, New York.

In F-2005-0418, Harbour Point Homeowner's Association is proposing the maintenance dredging of an historical footprint in Harbour Point Lagoon, in the Village of Northport, Suffolk County. The proposed project consists of maintenance dredging a 168,622 square foot area approximately 1,697 feet long, and 202 feet at its widest point. Sediment removal is proposed in order to maintain the use of the Association slips and maintain a safe navigational passage to deeper waters.

A total of 19,500 cubic yards of sediment will be required for removal from the complete footprint area. Dredging operations are proposed to be conducted using a mechanical clam-shell method with 17,500 cubic yards of material placement proposed for either the Western Long Island Sound Disposal Site (WLISDS) or Central Long Island Sound Disposal Site (CLISDS). The remaining 2,000 cubic yards of sediment will be removed with a hydraulic dredge and placed upland. Side slopes (3:1) are proposed within this footprint to prevent sloughing. Dredging is proposed to a control depth of -6.0 feet MLW with no overdredge allowance. All dredging and subsequent material placement activities will be conducted within an approved ACOE/DEC dredging window between October 1 and February 1.

their comments, in writing, no later than 4:30 p.m., **30 days from the date of publication of this notice, or September 2, 2005.**
