The New York State Department of State (DOS) is required by Federal law to provide timely public notice for the activity described below, which is subject to the consistency provisions of the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended.

The U.S. Coast Guard has determined that the proposed activity complies with and will be conducted in a manner consistent to the maximum extent practicable with the approved New York State Coastal Management Program. The consistency determination and accompanying public information and data is available for inspection at the New York State Department of State offices located at 41 State Street in Albany, New York.

**In F-2004-1046, the U.S. Coast Guard of 300 Metro Center Boulevard, Warwick, RI 02886**, is proposing to remove several large boulders from the boat basin at Orient Point Light, Orient, NY. The proposed project involves lifting four boulders from within the boat basin and placing them on the western edge of the west breakwater. Removal of these boulders is necessary because the Coast Guards Aids-to-Navigation Team Long Island Sound personnel normally access the lighthouse by entering the boat basin and climbing a breakwater ladder. With the boulders currently inhibiting safe use of the ladder and presenting a risk of small boat damage, ANT personnel would benefit from their removal. The proposed project is located at Orient Point in the Town of Southold, Suffolk County.
