Pursuant to 42 CFR Section 447.205, the Department of Health hereby gives public notice of the following:

To conform to 2005 legislatively-mandated changes, the Department of Health proposes to amend the Title XIX (Medicaid) State Plan on recipient cost sharing charges.

Pursuant to the change in State law, effective August 1, 2005, pharmacy co-payments will be increased from \$2.00 to \$3.00 for each brand-name prescription drug dispensed and from \$0.50 to \$1.00 for each generic prescription drug dispensed.

The estimated annual decrease in State Medicaid expenditures is estimated to be \$2.25 million (State share) per State fiscal year.
