Pataki, Governor of the State of New York, do hereby adopt and promulgate the following regulations which have been recommended by the Municipal Police Training Council pursuant to the provisions of section eight hundred forty of the Executive Law. This action is taken pursuant to the authority vested in me by section eight hundred forty-two of such law and, as such, it is exempted from the rule making provisions of the State Administrative Procedure Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it known that amendments to sections 6025.3 and 6025.6 of Title 9 of the New York State Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations are hereby adopted and promulgated and shall be effective upon publication in the *State Register*.

1. Subdivision (c) of section 6025.3 of Title 9 NYCRR is amended to read as follows:

(c) (1) No peace officers, notwithstanding the date of their appoint-

ment, shall be allowed by their employer to carry or use a weapon during any phase of their official duties which constitutes on-duty employment, unless they have [, within six months of the effective date of this article or appointment, whichever is later,] satisfactorily completed a course of training approved by the council in the use of deadly physical force and firearms and other weapons, and annually receive instruction in deadly physical force and the use of firearms and other weapons as approved by the council.

(2) Every peace officer appointed after November 1, 1991 who is statutorily authorized to carry a weapon shall, within six months of appointment, satisfactorily complete a course of training approved by the council in the use of deadly physical force and firearms and other weapons.

2. Subdivision (b) of section 6025.6 of Title 9 NYCRR is amended to read as follows:

(b) (1) No employer shall allow any peace officer, notwithstanding when the officer was appointed, to carry or use a weapon during any phase of the officer's official duties, which constitutes on-duty employment, unless the officer has [within six months after September 1, 1980 or appointment, whichever is later,] satisfactorily completed a course of training as prescribed in section [6025.3(c)] 6025.3(c)(1) of this Part, and annually thereafter receives instruction in deadly physical force and the use of firearms and other weapons as approved by the council.

(2) Every peace officer appointed after November 1, 1991 who is statutorily authorized to carry a weapon shall, within six months of appointment, satisfactorily complete a course of training as prescribed in section 6025.3(c)(2) of this Part.
