2006-0129 Matter of Mark and Victoria Tedeschi of Moxie Inc., 4468 Brady Hill Road, Binghamton, NY 07666 for a variance concerning fire-safety requirements including those for sprinkler systems.

Involved is reconstruction of and an addition to an A-2 (assembly, a restaurant) occupancy of type VB-unprotected frame construction, two stories in height and approximately 4,300 square feet in gross floor area. It will be known as "Moxie's" and is located at 998 Conklin Road, Town of Conklin, County of Broome, State of New York.
