Purpose: The proposed amendments to the water quality standards regulations, 6 NYCRR Parts 700 - 704, are necessary to add, revise, and delete water quality standards, and to add and/or revise standard-setting procedures and related regulations, based upon the most current scientific information. The triennial review of the state's water quality standards is required by section 303c) of the Federal Clean Water Act, and its implementing regulations at 40 CFR Part 131.

Involved is the conversion of a two story building of wood frame construction from a dwelling to a business occupancy, known as "Trocair College" located at 315 Choate Avenue, City of Buffalo, County of Erie, State of New York.

2006-0850 Matter of Grace Baptist Church c/o Jim Cooke, 2525 Eggert Road, Tonawanda, NY 14150 for a variance concerning sprinkler requirements in basement.

Involved is the conversion and alteration of basement for assembly use in a two story, wood frame, building used as a religious assembly occupancy, known as "Grace Baptist Church" located at 2525 Eggert Road, Town of Tonawanda, County of Erie, State of New York.

2006-0875 Matter of John J. Gervaso, Tech Valley Printing, 2550 9th Ave, Watervliet, NY 12189 for a variance concerning fire safety issues including fire separations and footing depths.
