PUBLIC NOTICE Rockland County Solid Waste Management Authority Draft Request for Proposals Transfer Station Operations and Maintenance, Hauling, and Disposal Services

The Rockland County Solid Waste Management Authority ("the Authority") is seeking a Contractor or Contractors to provide operations and maintenance services, including receipt and transfer and/or hauling, and disposal of solid wastes at the Authority's Transfer Station located off Torne Valley Road in Hillburn, New York. The successful Proposer(s) shall commence services on March 1, 2007. The Transfer Station received approximately 85,000 tons of solid waste in calendar year 2005, however, the Authority does not provide any commitments regarding the quantities to be delivered in the future. Additional services, such as fueling station operation, segregation and storage of tires, recovery and storage of bulk metals, and segregation of White Goods with refrigerants will be required of the Contractor, as described in the Draft Request For Proposals ("DRFP"). Within the Transfer Station Building, the Authority operates a Recyclables Preprocessing Facility ("RPF"). There, wastes rich in recyclables, such as cardboard, metals, plastics, and clean wood waste are deposited and sorted for recovery of recyclables.

Proposals are being solicited for either of the following two (2) options:

Proposal Option 1: Full Service

Contractor will be fully responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Transfer Station, as well as making certain Facility improvements. This will include receipt, loading, and hauling of Solid Waste to the Contractor or the Authority provided Designated Disposal Facilities.

Note: Responses to Proposal Option 1 may also include provisions for the following:

A. Full Service Operation of RPF. Provide costs to operate and maintain the RPF, including marketing of recovered recyclables. The Authority will look favorably on proposals that include RPF operation.

All Options which include Transfer Station operation and maintenance by the Contractor require the successful Proposer to provide all labor, rolling stock, other operating equipment and its maintenance, and to handle all scheduling and logistics required for Transfer Station operation, as detailed in the DRFP, as well as ensuring compliance with Authority reporting and regulatory requirements of Applicable Law. Proposal Option 2: Haul and Dispose Only

The Contractor will be responsible to haul and dispose of Solid Waste to the Contractor or Authority provided Designated Disposal Facility(s). The Transfer Station operation and maintenance will continue to be the Authority's responsibility.

There will be a Pre-Proposal Conference on Wednesday, August 9, 2006 at 1:00 p.m. at the Authority's Conference Center on Torne Valley Road. Written comments and questions on the DRFP are due Monday, September 18, 2006 at 3:00 p.m.
