The applicant has certified that the proposed activity complies with and will be conducted in a manner consistent with the approved New York State Coastal Management Program. The applicant's consistency certification and accompanying public information and data are available for inspection at the New York State Department of State offices located at 41 State Street in Albany, New York.

In F-2004-0194, Constellation Energy has applied to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for the relicensing of the Nine Mile Point, Units 1 & 2, Nuclear Power facility. No changes to the operating parameters or power output is proposed as part of the relicensing

application. Similarly, no physical changes to the units and their ancillary equipment, hardware and infrastructure are proposed as part of the relicensing application at this time. A new license from the NRC would provide for 20 years of continued operation and power generation at Nine Mile Point beyond the present license terms which are to expire on August 22, 2009 for Unit 1 and on October 31, 2026 for Unit 2. The Nine Mile Point Nuclear Power facility is situated on Lake Ontario in the Town of Scriba, Oswego County.
