The New York State Department of State (DOS) is required by Federal regulations to provide timely public notice for the activities described below, which are subject to the consistency provisions of the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended.

The applicant has certified that the proposed activity complies with and will be conducted in a manner consistent with the approved New York State Coastal Management Program. The applicant's consistency certification and accompanying public information and data are available for inspection at the New York State Department of State offices

located at 41 State Street in Albany, New York.

In F-2006-0271, the United States Coast Guard is proposing the repair and upgrade of the existing boat haulout at the Base Buffalo facility in Buffalo Outer Harbor, in the City of Buffalo, Erie County, New York. The purpose for the proposed activity is to provide structural upgrades to an existing timber bulkhead so that the U.S. Coast Guard can continue to utilize its marine travel lift to remove small vessels for storage and repair. All work associated with this project is for the maintenance and rehabilitation of the existing operational boat basin at the U.S. Coast Guard, Sector Buffalo and is located within the property boundaries.

The proposed project includes (1) the relocation of steel superstructure to new pile supported foundation; (2) the demolition of existing pier steel piles and caisson; (3) selective demolition of the existing timber sheet pile bulkhead and concrete cap; (4) the installation of two new 24-inch diameter steel pipe piles for the relocated Boat Haulout Pier; (5) the installation of approximately 105 feet of new steel sheet pile anchored bulkhead; (6) the installation of 10 soil anchors; (7) the installation of new concrete cap and fascia and slab on-grade; (8) the installation of eight steel 10 x 42 piles; (9) backfilling between the existing bulkhead and the new bulkhead with selected structural steel; (10) and pressure grouting the closure between the new bulkhead returns and the existing bulkhead. The primary project impact is that the project is associated with filling approximately 1200 square feet of state waters.

Any interested parties and/or agencies desiring to express their views concerning (any of) the above proposed activities may do so by filing their comments, in writing, no later than 4:30 p.m., 15 days from the date of publication of this notice, or June 8, 2006.
