The New York State Department of State (DOS) is required by Federal law to provide timely public notice for the activity described below, which is subject to the consistency provisions of the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended.

The United States Coast Guard has determined that the proposed activity complies with and will be conducted in a manner consistent to the maximum extent practicable with the approved New York State Coastal Management Program. The consistency determination and accompanying public information and data is available for inspection at the New York State Department of State offices located at 41 State Street in Albany, New York.

In F-2006-0799 (DA), The United States Coast Guard (USCG) is proposing the construction of a Remote Fixed Facility which includes a communications tower and associated equipment near the Town of East Hampton's Recycling Center/Montauk Transfer Station in East Hampton, Suffolk County, New York. The USCG proposes to construct a 170-foot tall, three sided, self-supported, steel lattice communications tower with a direct finding antenna mounted on top. The addition of the direct finding antenna, mounting pole, and lightning rod would increase the total height of the tower to approximately 181-feet above ground level. The proposed tower would be enclosed by a new 55-foot by 115-foot fenced compound. Associated equipment within the compound would include a prefabricated equipment shelter that would be no more than 15 feet by 24 feet, a 20-kilowatt emergency generator on a concrete slab, and one 500-gallon above ground propane tank. The purpose of the proposed action is to modernize and replace the USCG's maritime search and rescue communications system in New York as a part of a nationwide mandate.

Any interested parties and/or agencies desiring to express their views concerning the above proposed activity may do so by filing their comments, in writing, no later than 4:30 p.m., 15 days from the date of publication of this notice, or November 9, 2006.
