Apartment Treatment within the County of Nassau, NY

The New York State Office of Mental Health (OMH) Long Island Field Office announces the availability of funds for Apartment Treatment beds within Nassau County. Under this RFP OMH intends to seek qualified not-for-profit provider(s) to operate 63 units of Apartment Treatment for individuals considered an OMH priority population. These units are currently operated by a Nassau housing provider and any proposal submitted in response to this RFP must include a plan for the transition of the existing clients. Proposed projects must be willing to accept all referrals through the Single Point of Access (SPA). Applicants whose proposals are approved will be notified of the number of beds that can be developed.

Apartment Treatment programs are designed to be transitional. The Program provides a high level of support and skills training to individuals in an apartment setting. Using an individualized assessment and service planning process, residents gain skills and independence, develop mastery over their psychiatric illness, learn to use community resources and develop natural community supports.

Child and Family Clinic-Plus

The New York State Office of Mental Health (OMH) is pleased to announce the implementation of Child and Family Clinic-Plus for the Long Island Region. Clinic-Plus will provide new opportunities for the early recognition and treatment of emotional disturbance in children. Child and Family Clinic-Plus providers will provide the following: broad-based screening in natural environments, comprehensive assessment, expanded clinic capacity, in-home services and evidence based treatment. This initiative creates the opportunity for OMH licensed clinics to apply for designation as a Child and Family Clinic-Plus.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS: Applicants must be a currently licensed OMH clinic provider (Article 28 or 31) in good standing. The provider must be a not-for-profit agency that is eligible to receive State Aid. In addition, applicants must currently be a part or apply for the Clinic Quality Improvement Initiative under OMH. Materials available include the Guidance Document for Child and Family Clinic-Plus (which contains detailed programmatic, clinical and fiscal guidance), the Clinic-Plus Calculator (a tool for estimating service capacity and revenue), the Request for Proposal and the Request for Proposal Template (format for RFP response).

LETTER OF INTENT (MANDATORY): October 5, 2006. Agencies interested in responding to the Request for Proposal must submit a Letter of Intent to Bid to the Long Island Field Office by 5:00pm on October 5, 2006. The Letter of Intent shall be non-binding.

BIDDERS CONFERENCE (MANDATORY): October 11, 2006. Only those who have submitted a Letter of Intent can attend the Bidders Conference. Providers who have not attended the Bidders Conference will be disqualified and not considered.
