## **Dissemination Grants for Public Charter Schools**

Grant funds totaling approximately \$300,000 are available for competitive dissemination grants to charter schools that have been in operation for at least three consecutive years by December 1, 2007. Dissemination activities include assisting other schools in adapting the applicant charter school's program or certain aspects of the program or disseminating information on successful practices in the applicant charter school to other schools. Grants will range from \$100,000 to \$200,000 per year for two years subject to the availability funds from the United States Department of Education.
