NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

To: New York State Onion Growers:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE OF A REFERENDUM to be conducted by the Commissioner of Agriculture and Markets of the State of New York, pursuant to Article 25 of the Agriculture and Markets Law and section 203.13 of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York (1 NYCRR) on whether the New York State Onion Research and Development Program should be continued. The continuation of the order is subject to the approval of not less than 50 percent of all New York State onion growers participating in the referendum.

Any person who, in 2008, produced or caused to be produced onions in the State of New York for any market is a grower entitled to vote in this referendum. Each producer is entitled to one vote.

2008-0594 Matter of Bradley Rosenstein, 42 State Street, Albany, NY for a variance concerning fire safety issues including the penetration of a party wall.

Involved is the installation of several openings in an existing party wall and the expansion of an existing restaurant into an neighboring building. The building contains an A-2 occupancy is 4 stories in height of Type IIIB (ordinary) construction, having a cumulative gross floor area of 9,300 square feet.
