SOLICITATION FOR PROPOSALS TO PROVIDE RECYCLABLE MATERIAL COLLECTION AND/OR PROCESSING

Notice is hereby given that proposals for the City of Buffalo for the COLLECTION AND PROCESSING of single stream recyclables will be received by the Commissioner of Public Works, Parks and Streets on February 26, 2010 until 2:00 pm local time, at Buffalo City Hall, Room 502, 65 Niagara Street, Buffalo, NY, 14202.

In accordance with New York State General Municipal Law 120-w, it is the intention of the City of Buffalo to enter into negotiations for an agreement with contractor(s) whose proposal(s), in the judgment of the City of Buffalo, best serves the City of Buffalo's recycling program considering net costs to the City of Buffalo, technical feasibility and reliability, financial condition, resources, risk allocation, and experience with similar recycling operations.
