

EXECUTIVE ORDERS

Executive Order No. 18: Temporary Suspension of Provisions Relating to Transportation for the State Disaster Emergency.

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2011, I issued Executive Order Number 17 declaring a disaster emergency in the State of New York;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANDREW M. CUOMO, Governor of the State of New York, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 29-a of Article 2-B of the Executive Law to temporarily suspend specific provisions of any statute, local law, ordinance, orders, rules or regulations, or parts thereof, of any agency during a State disaster emergency, if compliance with such provisions would prevent, hinder or delay action necessary to cope with the disaster, hereby temporarily suspend, for the period from the date of this Executive Order until further notice, the following laws:

Sections 375, 385 and 401 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, to the extent that exemption from the vehicle registration, equipment and dimension requirements for vehicles validly registered in other jurisdictions is necessary to assist in disaster preparedness and recovery efforts.

Executive Order No. 19: Temporary Suspension of Provisions Relating to Transportation Infrastructure Recovery for the State Disaster Emergency.

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2011, I issued Executive Order Number 17 declaring a disaster emergency in the State of New York;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANDREW M. CUOMO, Governor of the State of New York, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 29-a of Article 2-B of the Executive Law to temporarily suspend specific provisions of any statute, local law, ordinance, orders, rules or regulations, or parts thereof, of any agency during a State disaster emergency, if compliance with such provisions would prevent, hinder or delay action necessary to cope with the disaster, hereby temporarily suspend, for the period from the date of this Executive Order until further notice, the following laws:

Section 38(1), (2) and (3) of the Highway Law and Article 4-C of the Economic Development Law, in the event that the Commissioner of Transportation determines it necessary to authorize the award of emergency contracts and/or to combine design and construction services in contracts and to use such services when needed;

Section 112 of the State Finance Law, to the extent consistent with Article V, Section 1 of the State Constitution, and to the extent that the Commissioner of Transportation determines it necessary to add additional work, sites and time to State contracts or award emergency contracts;

Section 136-a of the State Finance Law, to the extent that the Commissioner of Transportation determines it necessary to combine design and construction services in one contract and/or to obtain design and construction inspection services;

Section 163 of the State Finance Law, to the extent of allowing the Commissioner of Transportation to purchase necessary commodities and materials without following the standard procurement process; and

Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law, and Part 15 of Title 17 and Part 617 of Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations, to the extent that the Commissioner of Transportation determines that work is immediately necessary for the replacement, rehabilitation, or reconstruction of structures and facilities in response to the emergency and is performed to cause the least change or disturbance to the environment as is reasonably practicable under the circumstances.

Executive Order No. 20: Temporary Suspension of Provisions Relating to Domestic Violence Shelters for the State Disaster Emergency.

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2011, I issued Executive Order Number 17 declaring a disaster emergency in the State of New York;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANDREW M. CUOMO, Governor of the State of New York, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 29-a of Article 2-B of the Executive Law to temporarily suspend specific provisions of any statute, local law, ordinance, orders, rules or regulations, or parts thereof, of any agency during a State disaster emergency, if compliance with such provisions would prevent, hinder or delay action necessary to cope with the disaster, hereby temporarily suspend, for the period from the date of this Executive Order until further notice, the following regulations:

Parts 452, 453, 454 and 455 of Title 18 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations, to allow residential programs for victims of domestic violence in Schoharie County to provide emergency shelter to women and children who are homeless.
