

EXECUTIVE ORDERS

Executive Order No. 118: Continuing the Suspension or Modification of Certain Provisions of Law and Regulations.

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 103 declaring a disaster emergency in the Counties of Broome, Chenango, Clinton, Delaware, Essex, Franklin, Herkimer, Madison, Montgomery, Oneida, Otsego, Tioga, Schoharie, St. Lawrence and Warren; and

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 108 amending Executive Order Number 103 to additionally declare a disaster emergency in the County of Niagara; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-a of the Executive Law authorizes the suspension, alteration or modification of statutes, local laws, ordinances, orders, rules or regulations, or parts thereof, if compliance with such provisions would prevent, hinder or delay action necessary to cope with a disaster emergency; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 104 to temporarily suspend statutory and regulatory provisions relating to transportation infrastructure recovery; and

WHEREAS, on July 31, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 111 to continue the suspension of statutory and regulatory provisions ordered by Executive Order Number 104 through August 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on September 6, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 113 to continue the suspension of statutory and regulatory provisions ordered by Executive Order Number 104 through September 29, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 114 to continue the suspension of statutory and regulatory provisions ordered by Executive Order Number 104 through October 29, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 117 to continue the suspension of statutory and regulatory provisions ordered by Executive Order Number 104 through November 28, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-a of the Executive Law provides that no suspension of laws shall be made for a period in excess of thirty days, provided, however, that upon reconsideration of all of the relevant facts and circumstances, the suspension may be extended for additional thirty-day periods;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANDREW M. CUOMO, Governor of the State of New York, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 29-a of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, and after having reconsidered all of the relevant facts and circumstances, do hereby order that the suspension of statutory and regulatory provisions ordered by Executive Order Number 104, as extended by Executive Order Number 117, be continued, effective November 29, 2013, through December 28, 2013.
