Pursuant to Insurance Law section 2305, the New York State Department of Financial Services hereby gives notice of a public hearing:

Time and Date: 11:00 a.m. on June 25, 2013

Purpose: The purpose of the public hearing is to determine whether the Superintendent of Financial Services should approve a proposed workers' compensation insurance 2013 loss cost increase of 16.9 percent that was filed with the Department of Financial Services by the New York Compensation Insurance Rating Board, to be effective October 1, 2013. If approved, the loss cost will be used by workers' compensation insurance companies in setting their rates.

The hearing is open to the public. Interested parties may testify at the hearing or submit written comments to be included in the hearing record. Each speaker will be allowed up to five minutes for oral testimony. The Department of Financial Services will accept written comments for up to five business days after the hearing.
