

# EXECUTIVE ORDERS

---

**Executive Order No. 112: Continuing the Suspension of Certain Provisions of Law in the Counties of Bronx, Kings, Nassau, New York, Orange, Putnam, Queens, Richmond, Rockland, Suffolk, Sullivan, Ulster and Westchester.**

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2012, I issued Executive Order Number 47, declaring a disaster emergency in all 62 counties in the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 98 continuing the declaration of a disaster in the counties of Bronx, Kings, Nassau, New York, Orange, Putnam, Queens, Richmond, Rockland, Suffolk, Sullivan, Ulster and Westchester for ninety days; and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 109 continuing the declaration of a disaster in the counties of Bronx, Kings, Nassau, New York, Orange, Putnam, Queens, Richmond, Rockland, Suffolk, Sullivan, Ulster and Westchester for an additional ninety days; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 99 to suspend provisions of the Public Authorities Law to allow the MTA to expedite the award of contracts in order to promptly perform necessary critical repairs, reconstruction, rehabilitation and mitigation work and to maximize the use of federal assistance money; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 101 to continue the suspension of provisions of the Public Authorities Law as ordered by Executive Order Number 99; and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 109 to continue the suspension of provisions of the Public Authorities Law as ordered by Executive Order Number 99 and continued by Executive Order Number 101; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-a of the Executive Law provides that no suspension of laws shall be made for a period in excess of thirty days, provided, however, that upon reconsideration of all of the relevant facts and circumstances, the suspension may be extended for additional thirty-day periods;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANDREW M. CUOMO, Governor of the State of New York, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 29-a of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, and after having reconsidered all of the relevant facts and circumstances, do hereby order that the suspension of laws ordered by Executive Order Number 99 and continued by Executive Order Number 109 shall be continued, effective August 15, 2013, through September 14, 2013.

**Executive Order No. 113: Continuing the Suspension or Modification of Certain Provisions of Law and Regulations.**

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 103 declaring a disaster emergency in the Counties of Broome,

Chenango, Clinton, Delaware, Essex, Franklin, Herkimer, Madison, Montgomery, Oneida, Otsego, Tioga, Schoharie, St. Lawrence and Warren; and

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 108 amending Executive Order Number 103 to additionally declare a disaster emergency in the County of Niagara; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-a of the Executive Law authorizes the suspension, alteration or modification of statutes, local laws, ordinances, orders, rules or regulations, or parts thereof, if compliance with such provisions would prevent, hinder or delay action necessary to cope with a disaster emergency; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 104 to temporarily suspend statutory and regulatory provisions relating to transportation infrastructure recovery; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 105 to temporarily suspend statutory and regulatory provisions relating to State contracts and the repair of state facilities; and

WHEREAS, on July 31, 2013, I issued Executive Order Number 111 to continue the suspension of statutory and regulatory provisions ordered by Executive Order Numbers 104 and 105 through August 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-a of the Executive Law provides that no suspension of laws shall be made for a period in excess of thirty days, provided, however, that upon reconsideration of all of the relevant facts and circumstances, the suspension may be extended for additional thirty-day periods;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANDREW M. CUOMO, Governor of the State of New York, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 29-a of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, and after having reconsidered all of the relevant facts and circumstances, do hereby order that the suspension of statutory and regulatory provisions ordered by Executive Order Numbers 104 and 105, as extended by Executive Order Number 111, be continued, effective August 30, 2013, through September 29, 2013.
