In accordance with the New York State Waterfront Revitalization of Coastal Areas and Inland Waterways Act and the New York State Coastal Management Program, the Village of Alexandria Bay and Town of Alexandria, located within Jefferson County and the Thousand Islands region, have prepared a joint Draft Local Waterfront Revitalization Program (LWRP).
