Alkaline hydrolysis is a permissible means of disposal of pet remains. An entity offering pet disposal by alkaline hydrolysis for a fee must be licensed under General Business Law Article 35-C and such an entity can be licensed as a pet crematorium. *August 4, 2015*

The procedure prescribed by Public Housing Law § 34 to remove a member of the Authority's board applies to the members who sit on the board by virtue of election by the tenants of the Authority. *August 4, 2015*

General Municipal Law §§ 360, 360(2), 360(3), 360(5), Art. 14-A

General Municipal Law § 360 does not apply to the Town's proposed participation in a pilot Community Choice Aggregation program and thus section 360's requirement of a referendum likewise does not apply. *June 26, 2015*
