Rules Continued Without Modification

Pursuant to section 207 of the State Administrative Procedure Act (SAPA), notice is hereby provided that upon publication of the Five Year Review of Existing Regulations and the conclusion of the forty-five (45) day public comment period, no public comments were received regarding any of the subject rules. The rules referenced herein have functioned consistent with the purposes underlying their adoption and shall be continued without modification.

2001

Amendment to Chapter I of Title 4 of NYCRR (Rules for the Classified Service)

The resolution repealed prior section 4.11 and 4.12 and added a new section 4.11. This rule describes the rights and limitations associated with “contingent permanent” appointments to positions in the competitive, non-competitive and labor classes.

Amendments to Chapter II of 4 NYCRR (Attendance Rules for Employees in New York State Departments and Institutions)

The resolution amended sections 28-1.3(b), 28-2.1(c) and 28-3.7(a) and (c) upon the request of the Governor’s Office of Employee Relations to provide for the use of certain sick leave accruals by qualified managerial/confidential employees to pay for retiree health insurance premiums. Other changes provide for rules governing donations of leave credits by managerial/confidential employees.

2006

Amendment to Chapter I of Title 4 of NYCRR (Rules for the Classified Service)

The resolution added a new paragraph (viii) to subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of Rule 4.5 to provide for a probationary term for the positions of “University Police Officer 1 and “University Police Officer 1 (Spanish Language)” of not less than 52 weeks nor more than 78 weeks.

Amendment to Chapter V of Title 4 of NYCRR (Regulations of the Department of Civil Service [President’s Regulations])

This resolution accords with Public Officers Law requirements regarding the acknowledgement of public requests for records and the Department’s response thereto.

2011

Amendment to Chapter V of Title 4 of NYCRR (Regulations of the Department of Civil Service [President’s Regulations])

The resolution amended Rule 72.1 designating units for suspension, demotion or displacement within the Department of Environmental Conservation.

Amendment to Chapter V of Title 4 of NYCRR (Regulations of the Department of Civil Service [President’s Regulations])

This resolution amended section 73.2(e) regarding the authority of the President of the State Civil Service Commission, as head of the Department, to disqualify dependents of covered employees who have attempted to secure participation or benefits for themselves or another

in the health insurance plan authorized by Civil Service Law Art. 11, through fraud, deception or a material false statement, or has accepted benefits personally or for another knowing s/h was not entitled thereto.
