Dredging will be completed via a clamshell bucket in an 0.55 acre area at the mouth of Jomarr Basin to a depth of -6.0 feet with a one (1) foot over depth. Initial dredging will result in ~1,700 cubic yards of dredged material. Dredged material would be placed on a barge and transported to a dewatering area at the applicant owned Tobay Beach and Marina parking facility where it will be dewatered for 12 weeks

and then transported via truck to a DEC approved upland disposal facility. One (1) additional dredging event is anticipated with the removal of up to ~2,000 cubic yards of material, with the material dewatered and placed at a state approved upland disposal facility. A portion of the proposed dredging area has previously been dredged as recently as the year 2000.

In F-2018-0291 (DA), The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New York District, (Corps) is proposing maintenance dredging of the Ward Point Bend Reach Federal Navigation Project (FNP) in the NY & NJ Channels, Arthur Kill/Raritan Bay, Borough of Staten Island, City of New York, Richmond County.

The Corps has provided the following statements in the submitted consistency determination and public notice:

The New York District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers proposes to perform maintenance dredging of Ward Point Bend Reach, New York and New Jersey Channels. The Ward Point Bend Reach was last dredged in 2014 by commercial clamshell dredge, with the removal of

approximately 249,185 cubic yards (CY) of sediment. The dredged material was used as remediation material at the Historic Area Remediation Site (HARS). This proposed maintenance dredging would involve the removal of approximately 200,000 CY of material to 35 feet MLLW plus 2 feet allowable overdepth. Maintenance dredging of the channel is usually accomplished by a clamshell dredge, hopper dredge, or similar plant. The entire reach will generally not require maintenance dredging; only areas where shoaling has reduced the depth of the channel will require dredging.

The purpose of the proposed dredging is to maintain the authorized project dimensions, thereby assuring safe and economical use of Ward Point Bend by shipping interests. The material has been tested and meets the criteria for remediation material at the HARS. The dredged material would be used as such by placing it over degraded sediments within the HARS. The proposed dredged material would be transported by bottom dumping vessels to the placement site.

The material to be placed at the HARS is dredged material that will be removed from Ward Point Bend Reach, New York and New Jersey Channels Federal Navigation Project. The material has been evaluated and found to meet the regulatory testing criteria of 40 CFR Sections 227.6 and 227.27 and the requirements of the rule establishing the HARS in Section 228.15(d)(6).
