A solid waste/sludge composting facility, pursuant to section 120-W of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, for the following two options:

1. A full service contract for design, construction and operation of the composting facility for one year after start-up and demonstration testing.
2. A full service contract for design, construction and operation of the composting facility for 20 years after start-up and demonstration testing.

Submission of the proposal must be received at Southold Town Hall by September 20, 1988.

A fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), payable to the Town of Southold and nonrefundable, will be required of all bidders for a copy of the Final Request for Proposals document.

Routine Program Implementation Notice

STATEWIDE—pursuant to 15 CFR 923.84(b), the New York State Department of State (DOS) hereby gives notice that the federal Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management (OCRM) concurred on July 26, 1988 with DOS on one routine program implementation action. The action is the incorporation of the **Town of Brant Local Waterfront Revitalization Program** into New York State's Coastal Management Program (CMP). DOS requested OCRM's concurrence on October 27, 1986 for the Town of Brant in a previous notice in the *State Register* which further describes the content of the implementation action.

Pursuant to the State CMP and Article 42 of the NYS Executive Law the NYS Secretary of State approved the Town of Brant LWRP on January 20, 1988.
